

LOCATION:

9204 Greenville-St. Marys Rd Ansonia 45303 (just north of Beamsville Cemetery)

FFATURES:

- 5 acres
- Hiking trails (.5 miles)
- State Scenic Stillwater River

Donated by the Gerald Campbell family in 2009 and opened in 2012, this 5-acre park is located along the headwaters of the State Scenic Stillwater River. It is a fine example of a riparian habitat, an ecosystem found along river banks. The park is full of silver maple, box elder and American sycamore trees and is home to beaver, raccoon, fox, deer, a variety of reptiles and amphibians, muskrat, woodpecker and more. As you walk the trails, be on the lookout for signs and evidence of this bountiful wildlife.

Future plans for the preserve include constructing a canoe and kayak launch to provide anglers and paddlers easy access to the headwaters of the Stillwater River.
