Just off OH-502 on Spring Hill Rd.

naturally diverse with a variety of habitats. The trail head begins at a restored prairie where Indian Grass towers overhead, followed by a stand of White Pine trees that make an ideal roosting area for Wild Turkeys and Great Horned Owls. It then proceeds into a thicket of wild Hawthorn and Crab Apple, which attracts many birds and animals with its abundant food supply and natural shelter. The trail then gives way to a flood plain and a stretch of scenic Greenville Creek that remains in its natural state, having never been dredged or channelized. The diverse flora and fauna and meandering stream make the Worth Family Nature Preserve an exceptional natural area to visit during any time of year.
